B. High School Completion

As per federal regulation, MCNY’s Financial Aid Office must receive documentation of your high school diploma, recognized equivalent or home-school credential.

Note: The documentation must be submitted to the MCNY’s Financial Aid Office, even if previously provided to another MCNY office/department (such as the Admission Office).

Provide one of the following documents to indicate the student’s high school completion status when the student begins college in 2018–2019:

- ___ A copy of the student’s high school diploma
- ___ For students who completed secondary education in a foreign country, a copy of the “secondary school leaving certificate” or other similar document.
- ___ A copy of the student’s final official high school transcript that shows the date when the diploma was awarded.
- ___ A state certificate or transcript received by a student after the student passed a State authorized examination that the State recognizes as the equivalent of a high school diploma (GED test, HiSET, TASC, or other State-authorized examination).
- ___ An academic transcript that indicates the student successfully completed at least a two-year program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor’s degree.
- ___ For a student who was homeschooled in a state where state law requires the student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschooling (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a copy of that credential.
- ___ For a student who was homeschooled in a state where state law does not require the student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschooling (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a transcript, or the equivalent, signed by the student’s parent or guardian, that lists the secondary school courses the student completed and includes a statement that the student successfully completed a secondary school education in a homeschool setting.

A student who is unable to obtain the documentation listed above must contact the financial aid office.
