# VA WORK STUDY

We have two positions for a federal VA Work Study Program!

## Details:

- **Eligibility:** You must be certified and using VA education program (GI Bill, VR&E, Chapter 35) and be enrolled  $\frac{3}{4}$ -time
- **Compensation:** Paid hourly at federal or state minimum wage
- **Payment Schedule:** Payments are made every 50 hours or biweekly
- **Hours:** You can work IN-PERSON up to 25 hours a week, 7 hours a day

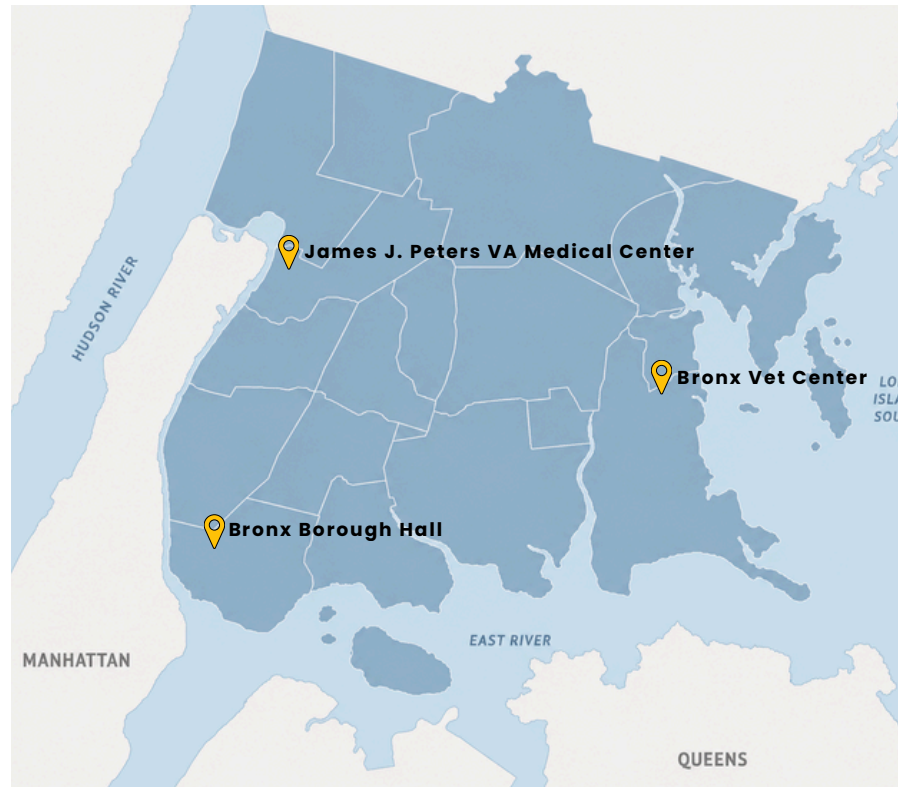
